ROSECRANCE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO TREATMENT

ROCKFORD, IL - Responding to the great need for detoxification and outpatient services, Rosecrance Health Network, a substance abuse treatment provider, has embarked on a \$3 million, nine month construction project to expand detox and adult outpatient services at the Rosecrance Harrison Adult Campus.

“This expansion project will help Rosecrance provide more timely access to services for those individuals who seek treatment. Detox is often the first step to treatment and recovery,” stated Philip Eaton, Rosecrance President and CEO. Rosecrance is the only provider of a full continuum of addiction treatment and detoxification services for an eight county area.

The Rosecrance Harrison Campus is the health network’s primary location for adult outpatient and inpatient treatment and detoxification services. The construction project includes:

- Increasing the number of detox beds from 16 to 24
- Adding a private waiting area, exam rooms, and restrooms in detox for the comfort of our family and friends
- Expanding outpatient waiting, reception and group counseling areas
- Increasing the number of private counseling offices in both outpatient and detox
- Installing a spacious, well equipped fitness/exercise center for patients

During the time it will take to complete this project, Rosecrance staff are taking measures to make the inconveniences as small as possible. “Noise, re-routing of traffic, and possible relocation of services are nuisances that are unavoidable, but we hope to

make everyone as comfortable as possible during this transition,” stated Craig Stallings, Administrator of Rosecrance Harrison Campus. This is the largest expansion project for the facility which was built in 1995.

Studies show that untreated substance abuse compromises not only an individual’s well-being but that of a family and the community. Rosecrance must currently turn away 2-4 adults daily who are seeking detoxification services or 1,000 - 1,500 people annually.

“When access to treatment is a problem...nothing good happens. When this project is complete, Rosecrance will be in an even stronger position to serve those in need by creating greater access,” added Eaton. “We are excited by this project and we know the community supports these efforts.”

Last year, Rosecrance served approximately 4,400 adults through their inpatient, outpatient and detoxification services. An additional, 1,100 adolescent clients and their families also sought treatment through Rosecrance. Rosecrance is a multi-site treatment program with eight locations in the Rockford area. Satellite offices opened in Northfield and Naperville, IL in 2007 and a Beloit, WI site is scheduled for early 2008.
