**Rosecrance Health Network announces

ROCKFORD, IL – The Rosecrance Health Network recently announced a number of promotions and new appointments throughout their agency. The changes reflect the organization's positioning for additional expansion to meet the growing need for substance abuse treatment services.

Administrative appointments include the promotion of **Judi Jobe** to the position of Executive Vice President; **Janis Waddell** to Senior Vice President of Marketing; and **Lynne Vass** to Senior Vice President of Development. These position changes reflect the expanded responsibilities of each of these divisions.

She has been a Unit Coordinator at the Rosecrance Griffin Williamson Campus for adolescents since 2003.

In addition to position changes, Rosecrance has begun a \$3 million expansion project which will increase the number of detoxification unit beds, add private family waiting room and professional counseling space, and include a spacious fitness center for its clients. Scheduled for 2008 is the opening of a satellite office in Beloit, WI. This is the third site to open following the addition of offices in Northfield and Naperville, IL in 2007. Rosecrance operates eight locations in the Rockford area.
