# Monarch

## RECOVERY HOMES

Monarch Recovery Homes serve 28 adolescent females 15-20 years of age. This long-term residential program is designed to provide structure, ongoing support and safety, independent living skills and counseling in a drug-free environment.

### HILLMAN HOUSE



Hillman House is a beautifully restored home built in the late 1920s and located on the east side of Rockford. This home has a capacity to serve 14 young women.

### SULLIVAN HOUSE



Sullivan House is located in an historic, turn-of-the-century Victorian home on the near northeast side of Rockford. Capacity for this home is 14.

## SERVICES

Services focus on developing skills and personal characteristics needed for these young women to live independently in the community and/or effectively reintegrate with families or caregivers. An individualized transitional living plan for each resident includes the following:

- Basic life skills education and development
- Interpersonal skills building
- Individual and group counseling
- Family/caregiver education and counseling
- Educational advancement
- Vocational education and preparation
- Participation in 12-Step programs
- Relapse prevention and sober living
- Ongoing access to medical and mental health care
- Planning for successful reintegration into family and/or community

## STAFF

Qualified professionals, under the management of a clinical director, provide 24-hour supervision within a drug-free environment.

## ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Services for female adolescents 15-20 years of age who have completed a primary substance abuse treatment program
- Admission interview required after inquiry
- Guardian must be responsible for medical and mental health care
- Services are provided without regard to race, religion, national origin or ethnicity
