Monarch Program

Monarch is a long-term residential recovery program for teen girls. This program is designed to develop independent living skills and provide on-going support, safety and counseling in a drug-free environment for adolescent females who have completed a primary treatment program. Rosecrance has two Monarch Homes: a beautifully restored, turn-of-the-century home in a residential neighborhood, and a warm, prairie-style home on the Griffin Williamson Campus.

Program includes:

- Individual and group counseling
- Family education and counseling
- 12 Step meetings
- 24-hour supervision
- Discharge planning for successful reintegration
- Secondary/higher and vocational education opportunities
- Interpersonal skills training
- Life skills building
- Recreational activities
- Relapse prevention

Admission criteria

- Services for female adolescents 15-20 years of age who have completed a primary substance abuse treatment program
- Admission interview required after inquiry
- Guardian must be responsible for medical and mental health care
- Services are provided without regard to race, religion, national origin or ethnicity
