What is the Purpose of this Support Group?

The Rosecrance Alumni Adolescent Support Group assists recovering adolescents in maintaining sobriety.

The temptation to return to drugs and or alcohol use is greatly reduced when a recovering adolescent has support and can talk with fellow teens who have completed treatment and who seek to sustain a lasting recovery. This group is designed to provide recovery support for teens who might be struggling with issues at school, at home or in their social network that may lead to relapse.

The group is facilitated by Rosecrance staff but is not a treatment session or a therapy group. It does not replace attendance at an AA/NA meeting but is intended to support the teen in achieving lasting recovery.

What are the requirements to participate in the support group?

To participate in the group, you must:

- Be in recovery
- Be between ages 13 - 18
- Be involved in a 12 Step group
- Sign a consent form to participate (provided upon entering the program)

Is there a fee for participating in the support group?

Rosecrance offers this recovery support group at no charge. Recovering adolescents are invited to attend as long as they adhere to the rules. This is a closed meeting, which means that only a person in recovery can attend.

When and where does the group meet?

The Rosecrance Alumni Adolescent Support Group has two chapters, one in Naperville and the other in Frankfort. The Naperville group meets every 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month from 5:00 - 6:00 p.m. in Room 231 at Grace United Methodist Church, 300 E. Gartner Road. The Frankfort group meets every 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month from 5:00 - 6:00 p.m. in the library at Frankfort United Methodist Church, 215 Linden Drive.

Who is the facilitator of the recovery support group?

The Alumni Support Group is facilitated by David Sutor, MHS, CADC. David is the Alumni Coordinator at Rosecrance and is responsible for developing relationships with both alumni and their families, coordinating programs and activities and identifying alumni for volunteer programs.
