What is the Purpose of this Support Group?

The Rosecrance Alumni Support Group assists recovering individuals in maintaining their sobriety.

The temptation to return to drugs and or alcohol use is greatly reduced when recovering individuals have support and can talk with peers who have completed treatment and who seek to sustain a lasting recovery. This group is designed to provide recovery support for individuals who might be struggling with issues at school, at work, at home or in their social network that may lead to relapse.

The group is facilitated by Rosecrance staff but is not a treatment session or a therapy group. It does not replace attendance at an AA/NA meeting but is intended to support the individual in achieving lasting recovery.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SUPPORT GROUP?

To participate in the group, a person must:

- Be in recovery
- Be between ages 13 - 18 (adolescent)
- Be age 18 or older (adult)
- Be involved in a 12 Step group
- Sign a consent form to participate (provided upon entering the program)

IS THERE A FEE FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE SUPPORT GROUP?

Rosecrance offers this recovery support group at no charge. Recovering adolescents and adults are invited to attend as long as they adhere to the rules. This is a closed meeting, which means that only recovering individuals can attend.

WHEN AND WHERE DO THE ROCKFORD GROUPS MEET?

The Rosecrance Alumni Support Group has two Rockford chapters, one for adolescents and the other for adults.
