Adolescent Treatment

Located on 50 scenic acres, the Griffin Williamson Campus is a 78-bed treatment center for adolescents ages 12-18. This beautiful facility features an on-site school, a gymnasium and fitness center, and a healing garden.

- Initial biopsychosocial assessments
- Residential inpatient treatment
- Outpatient treatment
- Partial hospitalization
- Gender-specific counseling
- On-site school
- Integrated experiential therapies
- Extensive family programs
- Recovery Lifeline and alumni programs

Monarch Recovery Homes

Monarch is a long-term residential recovery program for adolescents ages 14-18 who have completed a primary treatment program. Monarch develops independent living skills

and provides on-going support, safety and counseling in a drug-free, home-like environment with 24-hour supervision.

Program includes:

- Individual and group counseling
- Family education and counseling
- 12 Step meetings
- Secondary/higher education opportunities
- Relapse prevention, interpersonal and independent living skills building
- Discharge planning for successful reintegration into family and community

Adult Treatment

Harrison Campus is designed to provide a therapeutic milieu conducive to recovery. The 56-bed adult treatment center includes open living and recreational space, a childcare center with playground, and a fitness center.

Program includes:

- Initial biopsychosocial assessments
- Residential inpatient treatment
- Partial hospitalization
- Outpatient treatment
- Suboxone treatment
- Dual diagnosis
- Gender-specific programming
- Young adult program for men
- Special outpatient programs for women with children and on-site childcare
- Continuing care
- Family and alumni programs

HomeBase Recovery Home

HomeBase, located in a 10-unit apartment complex, is a transitional living recovery program for young men, women and mothers with their children. Residents focus on the development of essential skills necessary to maintain lasting recovery. Qualified professionals provide 24-hour supervision in a drug-free setting.

Program includes:

- Outpatient counseling
- 12 Step meetings
- Life skills training
- Relapse prevention
- Recreational activities
- Discharge planning

The Health Center

The Health Center, located at the Harrison Campus, consolidates medical services under one division and is the access point to detoxification services on a 24/7 basis. Physicians, nurses, health specialists, unit technicians and clinical counselors work together with the patient to ensure that physical and medical needs are met while exploring treatment options.

Services include:

- A 24-bed, medically monitored, detoxification unit
- Patient Access Counselors (PAC) who assess every individual and provide discharge planning and referrals

- A therapeutic environment to withdraw from the drug(s) and prepare for the next treatment step
- Medically Assisted Recovery Clinic (MARC) that offers an alternative, evidence-based treatment method for opiate addicted individuals through the controlled use of Suboxone

Family Support

Our family programs are designed to provide answers to questions—not only how to cope with a loved one's addiction, but how the experience has affected the whole family.

Program includes:

- Support groups and individual sessions
- Three-day family education weekends
- Discharge planning
