ADOLESCENT CARE

Shaped by decades of experience caring for generations of teens and young adults, our approach to mental health and addiction treatment is guided by a fundamental truth: Not every child gets better the same way. Our immersive, evidence-based programs treat a range of mental health concerns, including mood disorders, anxiety disorders, trauma and abuse-related conditions, suicidal behaviors, and substance use disorders.

VETERANS

As an approved provider through the Veterans Affairs Community Care Network (VA-CCN), we remove barriers to care and provide treatment that addresses occupational and situational factors for those who have served. We serve veterans through our full continuum of care, including residential, outpatient, crisis services, and supportive housing.

RESILIENCE

Serving individuals in high-risk, high-stress professions which may spark grief, trauma, anxiety, or depression that can fuel substance use and mental health challenges. Our treatment provides a path to lasting recovery by addressing the complex biopsychosocial issues unique to the culture of firefighters, paramedics, healthcare personnel, law enforcement officers, military and veterans, and those at the front lines of serving our communities.

WOMEN WITH CHILDREN

One of the programs of its kind, our residential program for pregnant women and women with children helps families heal together. Includes on-site licensed daycare and age-appropriate support for children impacted by addiction.

GAMBLING AND OTHER PROCESS ADDICTIONS

Specialized outpatient treatment for process addictions such as gambling, sex, and gaming. Like all our programs, it is evidence-based and customized to meet your needs.

INTERVENTIONS

MEDICATION-ASSISTED TREATMENT

A program that incorporates approved medications to reduce cravings and withdrawal symptoms of opioid use disorder to lessen the risk of relapse. Used in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies.

TMS THERAPY FOR DEPRESSION & OCD

Transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS) is a noninvasive therapy for treatment-resistant depression and obsessive-compulsive disorder.

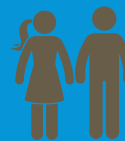

The Rosecrance Resilience Program serves individuals and families in high-risk, high-stress professions, which may spark grief, trauma, anxiety, or depression that can fuel substance use and mental health challenges.

This treatment program addresses behavioral health concerns while offering coping skills and building resiliency. It incorporates occupational factors into the treatment process and addresses complex biopsychosocial issues that are unique to the culture of safety-sensitive professions such as police, fire, emergency services, construction workers, healthcare professionals, and veterans.



SOBER LIVING FOR LONGER-TERM SUPPORT

Sober living and outpatient services at Rosecrance Lakeview are housed in a beautifully constructed building in Chicago's vibrant, historic Lakeview neighborhood.

Our recovery home residence caters to young adults and adults and offers the structure and accountability that is key during early recovery. The on-site outpatient counseling center provides treatment services to the community and conveniently for recovery home residents.



INSURANCE & FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Clients also have access to medically monitored detox care. Care for withdrawal management will be based on individual needs on a 24/7 basis.

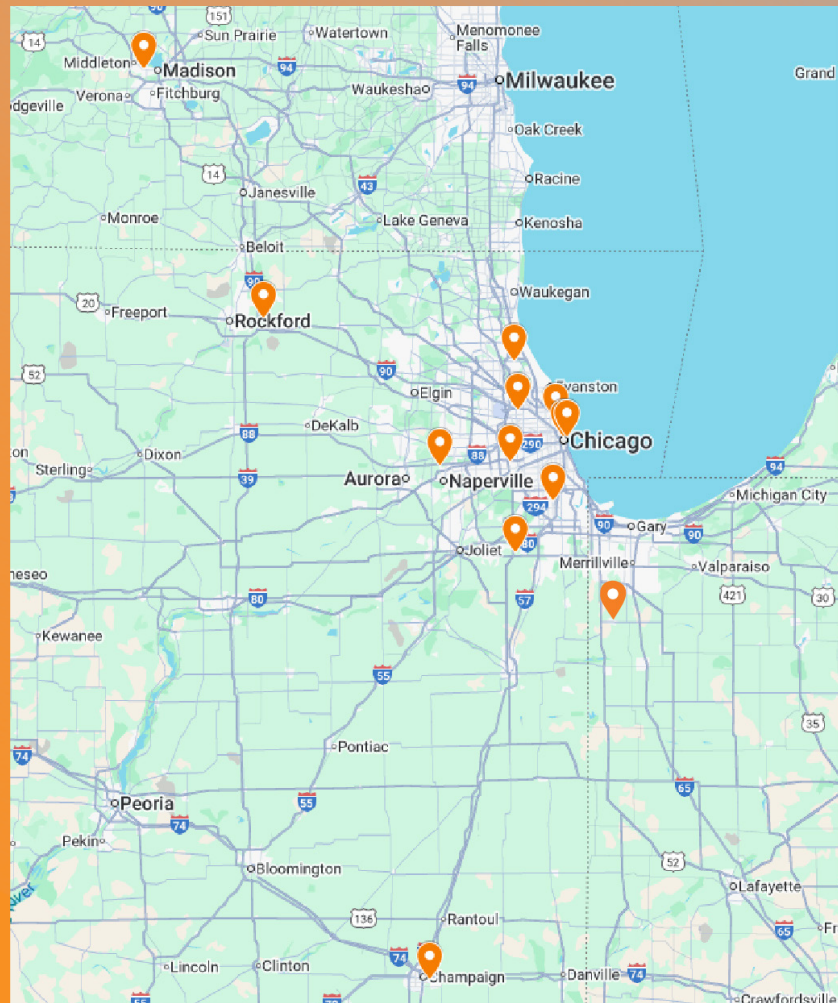

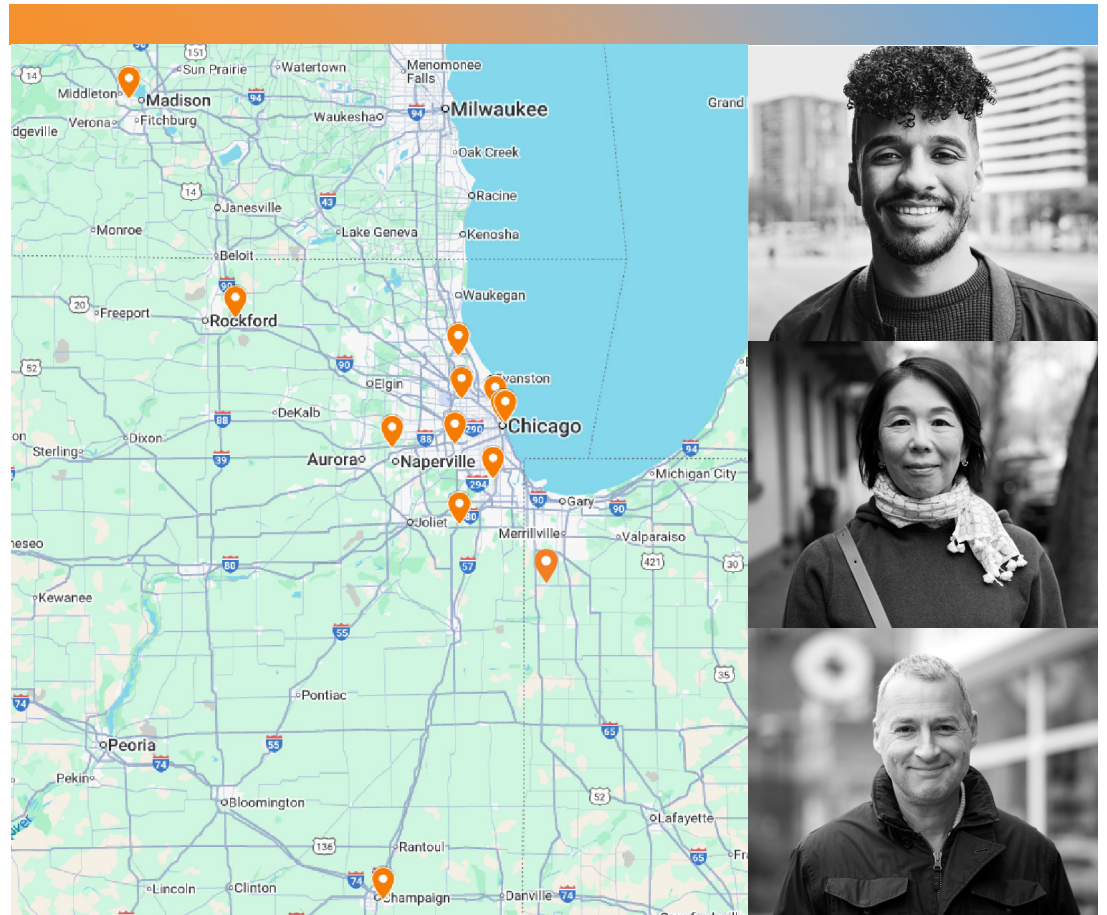
